### **Simulated Emergency Test EMERGENCY EXERCISE SCENARIO** (GOLDEN HORSESHOE)

On Saturday, September 20th, 2025, some members of the Hamilton Amateur Radio Club (HARC) participated in a pre-planned emergency radio exercise in cooperation with the Auxiliary Communications Services - Golden Horseshoe and its collective Ham Operators. The scenario of the exercise was that a severe storm had affected the wide spread Golden Horseshoe area. High winds of 90 to 100 KPH were pushing the waters of Lake Ontario towards the Hamilton beach strip, causing severe flooding along the beach front area. This situation was exasperated as Lake Ontario water levels were already at a high level. Due to high winds, power failures had occurred across the area. As a result of the power failures and high winds, cellular service and Internet had been compromised. Environment Canada had issued a storm warning for the next 24 hours.

### **PREPARATION**

To prepare for the exercise, Gary VE3TTO took the lead to organize HARC members to confirm who was available to assist. Ultimately, eight (8) operators were confirmed and assigned various rolls (simulated operations, typically from their own QTH), as follows;

- Hamilton Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) **Operations - Jim VA3HFD**
- Beach Area Pumping Operations Garnet VE3GNP
- Westmount Recreation Centre (Evacuation Centre) - Damien VA3COF
- Stoney Creek Recreation Centre (Evacuation Centre) - Gary VE3TTO
- Ancaster Recreation Centre (Evacuation Centre) -Rick VE3BK
- Beach Front Sandbagging Operations Dave **VE3DV**
- Salvation Army Support Group Jeff VE3BJL
- HF Radio Operator Barry VE3ISX

Each operator was provided with pre-scripted messages in advance to transmit to the Hamilton EOC at specific times relating to situation updates and resource requests, such as additional pumps, hoses, fuel, food and manpower support, as well as numbers of evacuees at each recreation centre. All of this information was actioned at the local level, with responses back to each individual site operator. In addition, relevant information was further passed up the line via radio to the Provincial Emergency Operations Centre (PEOC). A total of 3 Radiograms were transmitted to the Provincial EOC, as well as 2 reports via WINLINK. A Radiogram relating to a family member compassionate request (fictional scenario) was also passed via 2 meters to the Provincial EOC.

Throughout the exercise, an announcement was transmitted every 30 minutes over our operation repeater VE3WIK stating that the exercise was being conducted. Similar "Exercise Only" messages were also passed over repeater VE3URU by the Provincial EOC operators every 30 minutes.

### **AFTER ACTION REVIEW**

As with any exercise, hick-ups were experienced at all levels for various reasons; Afterall, that is why we do these exercises to ensure that we as licensed Amateur Radio Operators are able to effectively provide communications assistance should the need arise. Many lessons were learned at all levels, which we will endeavour to improve on in future planned exercises.

Bravo Zulu (BZ) to all Operators to who assisted. Hopefully we will have additional members involved in future exercises.

Note for those who may not be aware; BZ means "Well Done" in military jargon.
