- (A) Don't "keyup" without identifying. This is a common practice and is selfish and thoughtless.
- (B) Leave a space, pause between transmissions, in case someone wants to join in or has an emergency.
- (C) Don't interrupt an on going contact unless you have a reason to do so. If you do so, please give your callsign between transmissions.
- (D) Keep your transmissions short during a QSO.
- (E) Use of the word "breaker" should only be used for real emergencies.

Our Repeater is used by many non members. They may not know that HARC uses the repeater for activities associated with our club. We are all aware CANWARN, TFMCS Link System and Around the Bay Race to name a few.

When the repeater is in use for any approved event, I would suggest that members not active in the event choose another frequency to QSO or wait until the activity is over and returned to normal use.

Common sense and courtesy should be applied to all those amateurs trying to use the repeater. For those who do not understand, suggest they come out to a meeting and learn how our system works, and encourage them to join. Inform them the advantages of our club.

If you have not joined RAC, please remember they represent us to the governments, inform us through their monthly magazine activities concerning Canadian Amateurs. It costs money to run this organization and many new members means more action on behalf of amateurs. Twenty percent is not a strong enough voice to be heard in our Capital City.
